

CAPTURE IT 3D

Storing Capture It 3D Spaces on your iPad & iPhone

If you use an iOS device like an iPad or iPhone you can store your Capture It 3D Space and use it without an internet connection. (This is currently available for iOS devices only)

'3D Showcase' for iOS is an iPad and iPhone app which lets you store all of your Capture It 3D Spaces by downloading them locally to your device for easy browsing and exploring.

You will need to download the app from iTunes app store and then download the Space.

If your client(s) would like to store a copy on their iOS device, they can also download the app and enter the Access Code you supply them.

The actual process is quite easy and step-by-step instructions are below.

Technical Requirements/Process

3D Showcase for iOS is now supported for both iPad and iPhone. We recommend using iOS v9.3.1 or newer. You need an active iTunes account to download 3D Showcase for iOS. You must be connected to wifi or a cellular network to download Spaces. But once they are on your device, you can show them anywhere, anytime without needing to be internet connected.

1. Download Matterport 3D Showcase from the Apple app store.
 - a. Open App Store
 - b. Search on 'Matterport'
 - c. Click on 'Matterport 3D Showcase'
 - d. Download to your device
 - e. Open the app
2. Featured Spaces shows on screen
 - a. This will open and show you preloaded Spaces you can view
 - b. Has a variety of types of Spaces
 - c. Cannot delete these.
 - d. Six of them were shot by Capture It 3D
3. Click on the 'Cloud'
 - a. No need to 'log in'
 - b. Click on the Search 'Magnifying Glass'
 - c. Enter the 11 digit Access Code
 - d. Sample Code: rEuYzMM676k
 - e. Must enter upper and lower case as shown
 - f. Click on Search
4. Your 3D Space will appear
 - a. Click on the 'Download Cloud w/Arrow' under the lower, right corner
 - b. May be a little obscured by the address
 - c. Your 3D Space will then be dumped into your 'Downloaded' Spaces file

- d. May take a couple minutes depending on your connection
- e. You can then 'x' the search bar and enter the next access code
- 5. Click 'Cancel' once all your 3D Spaces are downloaded
 - a. Click on 'Downloaded'
 - b. Your Spaces are in this file
 - c. Click on a Space to view and/or show it

Now you have all your Capture It 3D Spaces in one file that is easy to access and to show!
